Cinnabaria Wilk et al.

The monospecific genus <u>Cinnabaria</u> was introduced by <u>Wilk et al. (2021)</u> to accommodate *C. Boliviana*. <u>Cinnabaria boliviana</u> is similar to members of the "Caloplaca" cinnabarina group, recently separated as <u>Brownliella</u>, but differs in ascospore size, among other features. The species is characterized by a yellowish, areolate thallus, sublobate at the margin, and immersed, red apothecia, contrasting with the thallus color (<u>Wilk et al. 2021</u>) (M. Erdoğdu).
