Based on combined evidence derived from the morphology and LSU sequence phylogeny, a monotypic truffle genus <u>Ahmadea</u> was introduced by <u>Aman et al. (2020)</u> to accommodate <u>A. dalanensis</u> found in arid and semi-arid regions of Punjab, Pakistan, often occurring in <u>Sorghum vulgare</u> Pers. fields where it has been known for its edibility for numerous decades (M. Erdoğdu).
