Odontotrematales Lücking

<u>Odontotrematales</u> was introduced to accommodate <u>Odontotremataceae</u> (<u>Lücking 2019</u>). The order comprised non-lichenized taxa which showed a close phylogenetic relationship to <u>Graphidales</u> and <u>Gyalectales</u> and clustered outside of <u>Ostropales sensu stricto</u> (<u>Kraichak et al. 2018</u>, <u>Lücking 2019</u>) (V. Thiyagaraja).
