Ramiphialis F.R. Barbosa et al.

Ramiphialis was introduced by <u>Barbosa et al. (2020)</u> to accommodate *R. ronuroensis* collected on decaying leaves from the Amazon rainforest in Brazil. The taxon is distinguished by macronematous, monophialidic and multibranched, discrete, and terminal and intercalary conidiogenous cells that produce filiform to falcate, unicellular, hyaline conidia (<u>Barbosa et al. 2020</u>) (M. Erdoğdu).
