Spirographaceae Flakus et al.

<u>Spirographaceae</u> was established to accommodate <u>Spirographa</u> which comprises lichenicolous and fungicolous taxa (<u>Flakus et al. 2019</u>). The family formed a clade close to <u>Graphidaceae</u> in the multigene phylogenetic analysis. However, the family was not studied by <u>Lücking (2019)</u> who revised and provided the latest classification for <u>Ostropales</u>. Therefore, the ordinal level classification of this family needs further revision (V. Thiyagaraja).
