Atrophysma T. Sprib.

This genus has been introduced by <u>Spribille et al. (2020)</u> and its features are: A cyanolichen with minutely coralloid, finger-like lobes over a black hypothallus, similar to *Placynthium* but ascospores are simple, similar to *Leciophysma* but with dark blue-black pigments in the apothecium; asci lacking an amyloid apical tube (F. Selcuk).
