Brahmaculus P.R. Johnst.

<u>Johnston et al. (2021)</u> introduced <u>Brahmaculus</u> in <u>Chlorociboriaceae</u> to accommodate four new species. All species of the genus have bright yellow apothecia with several apothecial cups held on short branches at the tip of a long stipe. They differ from species referred to <u>Chlorociboria</u> the only other genus in <u>Chlorociboriaceae</u>, in their terrestrial habitat and ascomata that are noticeably more hairy than the known <u>Chlorociboria</u> species, most of which have apothecia with short, macroscopically indistinct hair-like elements (<u>Johnston et al. 2021</u>) (M. Erdoğdu).
